



Corporate Milestones

- 1970** – Inventronics founded in Brandon, Manitoba to make electric heating controls
- 1977** – Begins manufacturing enclosures for the telecommunications market
- 1981** – Acquires manufacturing facility in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan
- 1988** – Acquires manufacturing facility in Edmonton, Alberta
- 1992** – Closes Moose Jaw facility, transfers production to Brandon and Edmonton
- 1997** – Transfers Edmonton operations to nearby Sherwood Park
- 2000** – Appoints new executive team
- 2001** – Acquires Eurocraft Enclosures Limited in Dudley, England
- 2002** – Brandon facility audited, certified to stringent new ISO 9001:2000 standard
 - [Consolidates North American production in Brandon](#) to save \$2 million a year, requiring closure of leased Sherwood Park facility
 - Sells [Eurocraft](#) in response to prolonged telecom downturn in Europe
 - Refinances balance sheet and adds [\\$2.5 million of working capital](#)
- 2003** – Achieves [dramatic reduction in costs and losses](#) while improving EBITDA
- 2004** – Continues to [improve EBITDA](#)
- 2005** – Returns to profitability
 - Introduces pedestals product line
